ORDER

Plaintiff Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington (“CREW”) brings this action against Defendant U.S. Department of Justice (“DoJ”), challenging its denial of Plaintiff’s requests under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA” or “the Act”), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Plaintiff’s FOIA requests sought materials relating to DoJ investigations of U.S. Representative Don Young involving allegations of bribery and other illegal conduct.

This matter is presently before the Court on Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment (“Def. Mot.”) [Dkt. No. 10] and Plaintiff’s Cross-Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (“Pl. Mot.”) [Dkt. No. 12]. Upon consideration of the Motions, Oppositions, and Replies, the entire record herein, and for the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is this 10th day of January, 2012, hereby

ORDERED, that Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment is **denied**; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiff’s Cross-Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is **granted**; and

it is further

ORDERED, that the Government shall file a Vaughn Index within 60 days of the date of this Order.
