

Preschool: Cognitive Development



Resources in Cognitive Development encourage the growth of language, math, science, and social studies skills in young learners. Play Spectacular Sounds Bingo to practice rhyming sounds to develop language skills. Children will develop math skills as they practice measuring with Sid the Science Kid. Experiments such as "Gas in a Bag" and "Rainbow Gel" can be previewed to encourage science exploration. In addition, social studies students will study their culture and community with virtual field trips to Biscayne National Park, the post office, and the hardware store. Cultural celebrations, democracy in action, and economics are also explored in Cognitive Development.




Preschool: Physical Development

Resources in Physical Development encourage the growth of gross and fine motor skills, as well as healthy living habits. Teachers can take students on virtual field trips to examine movement at the pottery studio, aquatic complex, or children's theatre using resources such as videos, lesson plans, and student support materials. Curious George encourages students to learn about the movement of air in a video that accompanies a lesson plan and encourages students to use their fine motor skills as they experiment and collect data. Grover and Cookie Monster will help excite young learners as they sort fruits and vegetables of every color. Additional resources encourage good mental, oral, visual, and auditory health in Physical Development.

Resources in Social And Emotional Development encourage children to develop positive peer and adult interactions and to manage self-expression and inner feelings. Many of our favorite characters, such as Daniel Tiger, Super Why, and Caillou, teach lessons on confronting our fears, working together as a team, and welcoming a new member to a family. Kindness is explored in a lesson that also challenges a student's artistic expression by making a Kindness Tree. An interactive activity can be used to encourage and teach appropriate social behaviors. Social problem solving, self awareness, and empathy are also explored.
